Tasting Notes: Defined, focused, stylish, bright, silky-smooth, beautifully balanced, a hint of lime, apples and spice, core of minerality, clean, long, lingering finish ... and just plain delicious to drink. You can taste the famous Green Valley fog in this wine. It is the opposite of big, buttery and oaky.

Background on Green Valley: Green Valley is one of the smallest, most tightly delineated AVAs in Sonoma County in the coolest foggiest most westerly part of the Russian River. It is a real appellation in the sense that the star wines from the area share certain, genuine, discernible flavors. There are over 100 growers ... and eight key producers: Dutton-Goldfield, Dutton Estate, goldridgepinot, Iron Horse, Hartford Court, Marimar Estate, Orogeny, and Tandem.

& Food: This Chardonnay tastes one way on its own, and then changes dramatically with the pairing. Its versatility makes it a great restaurant wine. It's surprising what this wine can carry.

The winery's current favorites include: shaved fennel salad with a squeeze of blood orange - grilled chicken with Dijon mustard and arugula - warm spinach salad with bacon and a brown sugar and balsamic dressing - spicy shrimp, a simple risotto with Parmesan cheese and sweet butter - grilled Ahi tuna with romesco sauce, tortilla soup, warm, chewy, wood fire-oven flatbread, drizzled with truffle oil - a perfect Gravenstein apple and a slice of Toma cheese
